# Minutes of the 12<sup>th</sup> IQAC meeting held on 30<sup>th</sup> June 2018 at 10.00 am in the Principal's chamber.

- The meeting commenced with the welcome address by Dr. P. Vijayakumar, Principal and chairperson of IQAC
- Mr. P.Sundaram, Director IQAC before initiating the discussion introduced the newly nominated members of IQAC.
- He went on highlighting the achievements of the instituiton in academic, action taken over the minutes on the previous meetings. He further explained the plan of action for the academic year 2018 – 2019 and welcomed additional ideas for fine tuning the plan and for finalizing it.
- He further explained that the NAAC is making a number of changes in the guidelines for IQAC formation and AQAR preparation. He told that the IQAC of the instituiton is alive to the situation and acts swiftly in tune with the NAAC guidelines.
- The forum was open for discussion and Mr. B. Shanmuga sundaram came forward to support
  in design and fabrication for the industrial project on "Mechanised cable stripper" for III year
  mechanical engineering students as further steps in continuation of the steps taken earlier.
- He narrated the importance of revising the curriculum and syllabi based on the industrial needs and further mentioned that it is a long term process and we have to wait 6 to 8 years to see the fruits of the efforts.
- The discussion turned lively with the request of the student member Mr. M. Dinesh Banu to create a friendly atmosphere by the faculty members.
- The academic expert Dr. D. Bhanu, Alumini member Mr. S. Chandra mohan and Industrialist
  Mr. B. Shanmuga sundaram emphasized the need for present day students to have better
  communication skills besides practical knowledge gained in their campus life.
- Upon further discussion, it was decided to tone up our mentoring system and develop peer group involving both students and faculties to improve quality of learning.
- The academic expert Dr. D. Bhanu narrated the importance of a holistic development of the students in order to get placement and was appreciative of the present practices in the institution. She further narrated the importance of whole hearted participation of the students

- The alumini member Mr. S. Chandramohan stressed the need for improving the communication ability of the students and propagating the message of seizing every oppurtunity for improving their communication skills.
- Summarising the discussion the chairperson informed to the members of IQAC about students mentoring system and relevant training giving to a peer team of faculties in this regard. He assured for further improvements.

  of the 'Smart class room' courses and mentioned that subbmission of online
  assigenment is found easier.
